There is a limit of 3 cards that can be issued for any one slip.

Following are two subjects that we are re-addressing in this newsletter;

- 1) The color of umbrellas & umbrella covers. The only approved color for these items is "yellow". We have yellow umbrella covers in stock (yellow umbrellas are currently out-of-stock, expected in mid-July) other colors (even clear) are not approved and are no longer allowed. The cost for a cover is \$34.00. Contact H.C.C.M @ 269-469-4740.
- 2) <u>The color of dock boxes.</u> All brown dock boxes must be painted "white" by the end of this season (Nov. 15, 2006) or be removed from the property. Please be careful when repainting, clean-up can be expensive.

State public safety codes require that you shower before entering the pool c.) The bathhouse floors are slippery when wet d.) If needed, the emergency telephone in the pool enclosure should be used to call 911; this phone will identify our location to emergency personnel.
